Lunchtime Skipping Club	Children will have the opportunity to develop and practise their skipping skills and learn new games. This session is open to all children. No need to sign up, just 'drop in'.

Children participating in this club can either provide their own recorder or borrow one from school – there will be a returnable deposit, should your child chose to do this.
