I am writing to update you on some recent changes to staffing in Nursery. Miss Day has now left us to take up a new teaching position nearer to her home. We are currently recruiting for a new teacher. In the meantime we have secured Mrs Kim Clifford, an experienced teacher, from West Country Supply agency to cover the position.

Miss Hanna (TA) will also be leaving in the next few weeks to take up a different role within Acorn Education Trust. The rest of the TA team: Mrs Davies, Miss Hallett and Mrs Reitzner will continue to work in Nursery and will shortly be joined by two new TAs who we appointed last week.
