School Meals On-Line

From January we are changing our school meal booking system. You will have to pre-book on-line via the School Gateway using 'Meal Manager'. This will allow you to look at the options with your child. It will help ensure individuals have the meal they ordered as we will be checking this off in the kitchen beforehand.
