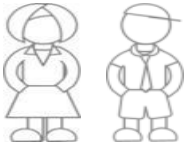

Girls and Boys performance in your school, compared to the overall national average.



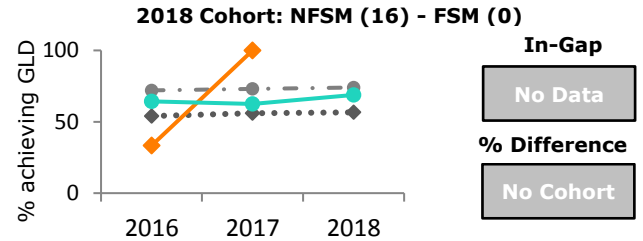
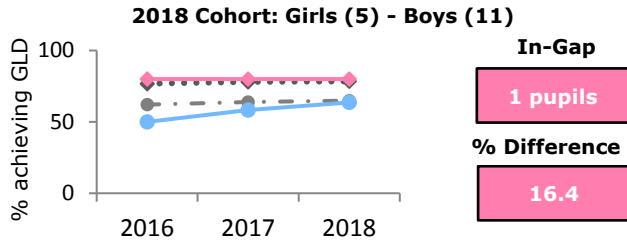
## FSM Ever6 Gap

Non-FSM and FSM Ever6 compared to the overall national average.



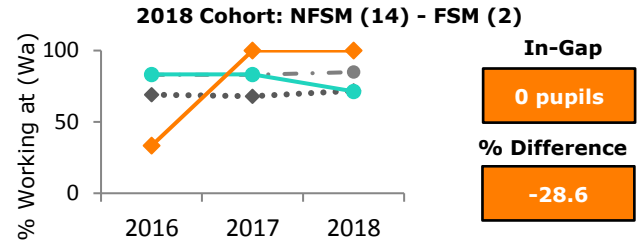
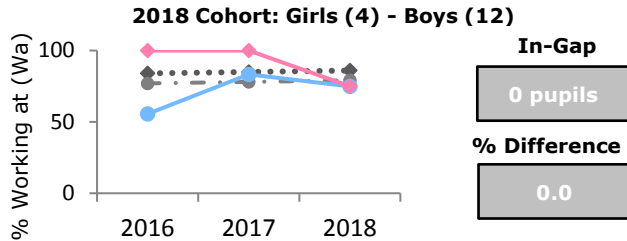

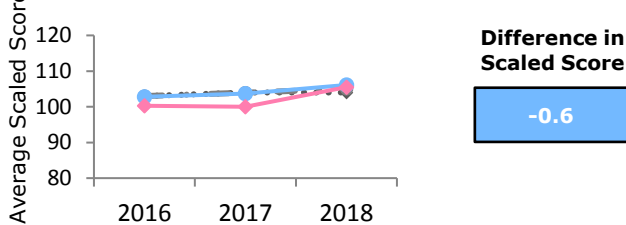
### Reading Average Scaled Score

2018 Cohort: NFSM (14) - FSM (2)



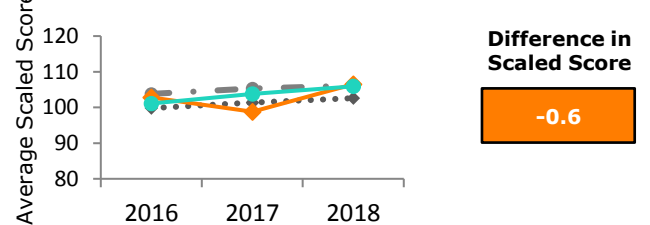
### Maths Average Scaled Score

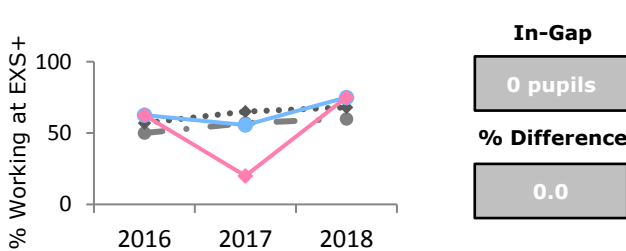

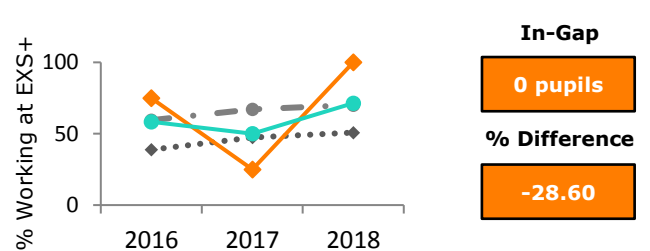

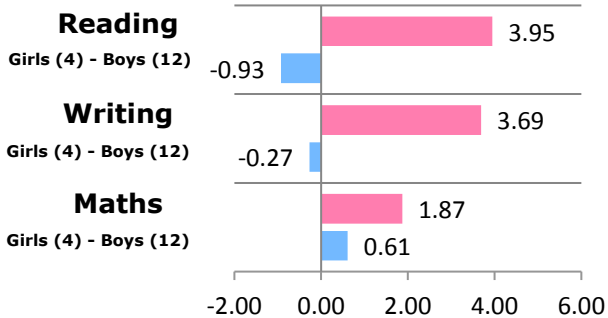

# Narrowing the Gap for Primary Schools

The 'Narrowing the Gap' report for primary schools provides instant information for differences in attainment for gender and FSM 6 pupils in your school.

The report shows the performance gap for all collections over the last three years:

- Gap between girls and boys
- Gap between non-FSM pupils and those pupils known to be FSM Ever 6

FSM ever 6 is not the same as RAISEonline/ASP "disadvantaged pupils" as we have not included Looked After Children or Adopted from Care. FSM ever 6 data that has been included in this analysis has been taken from NCER and may differ from figures that will be released by the DfE in Autumn 2018.

## In-Gap Calculation:

**Gender:** ((% of Girls achieving EXS+/GLD/Wa - % of Boys achieving EXS+/GLD/Wa) x number of boys in cohort)

**NFSM6/FSM6:** ((% of NFSM6 achieving EXS+/GLD/Wa - % of FSM6 achieving EXS+/GLD/Wa) x number of FSM6 in cohort)

## Data included in Analysis:

EYFSP: % achieving a Good Level of Development (GLD).

Phonics (Year 1): % Working At (Wa) the expected Phonics standard at the end of Year 1.

Key Stage 1: Expected Standard for Reading, Writing and Maths.

Key Stage 2: Expected Standard for Reading, Writing and Maths, Average Scaled Score for Reading and Maths, and percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in all three subjects. National gender averages for KS2 have been taken from the DfE KS2 Unvalidated Data that was released in September 2018. This data is provisional and may change.

## Small Cohorts

Please use caution with small cohorts. In a pupil group size of 10 pupils, each pupil's performance represents 10% of the group's performance. Should a pupil group have fewer than 10 pupils, a bold red warning will appear below the section heading in the analysis.

## Understanding the Analysis

The large boxes to the right of the charts show the in-gap and % difference in the 2018 data.

These boxes are colour coded and will reflect the group that had the higher attainment in 2018.

## Gender Gap

The Gender Gap is always girls - boys.

If the boxes are blue, this indicates that **boys** have outperformed girls. The Gap and % Difference will be **negative**.

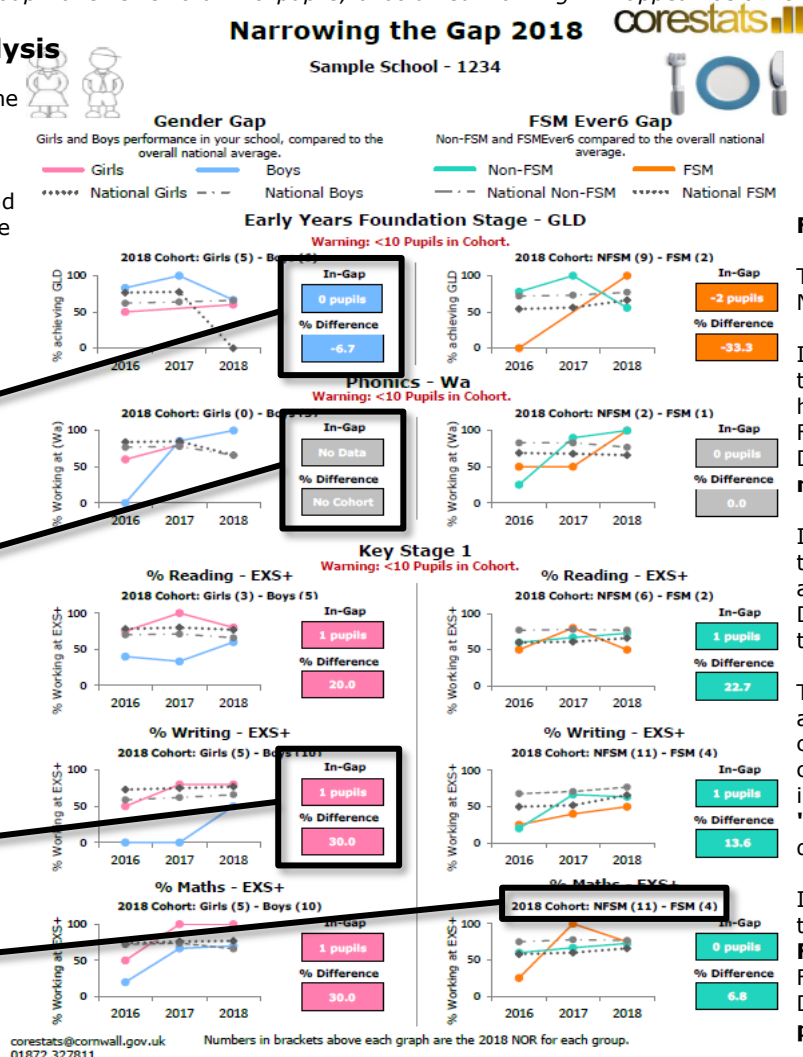
If the boxes are **grey**, this indicates that there is an In-Gap of 0 and 0% difference between the two pupil groups.

These boxes will also appear **grey** if there is no cohort to make a comparison. In these instances, 'No Data' and 'No Cohort' will be displayed.

If the boxes are **pink**, this indicates that **girls** have outperformed boys. The Gap and % Difference will be **positive**.

## Cohort Sizes

Above each graph, the numbers in brackets are 2018 pupil numbers for each group.



## Graph Comparisons

If no comparisons can be made because there were **no pupils** in one group, a gap will appear on the graph. However, if there are pupils in either group, but none of them achieved GLD, Wa or EXS+ (as appropriate), the graph will show a zero value.
