

Arty Challenges for LKS2 – Years 3 and 4

Drawing

Find two objects in your house – one that is natural e.g. a leaf, an apple, a plant etc. and one that is man-made e.g. a bottle, a toothbrush, a piece of cutlery etc. Have a go drawing them using whatever media you have at home – a pencil works as well as anything else! Remember to include patterns and textures that you can see.

Painting

Create a painting of your own choice – you could choose to paint an object/toy, do something from your imagination or recreate a character from a book, comic or computer game! The choice is yours!

Textiles

Make the first letter of your name by practising sewing buttons, beads and sequins.

You could use a mixture of these or just one of the above. You could use matching ones or odd ones – How interesting can you make your initial look?

Printing

Cut up some cardboard strips of different widths and lengths – dip them in paint (you can use one colour or different colours) and print onto paper. Have a go creating a pattern or picture. You could try printing a mandala like some of you did in school!

Sculpture

You may want to wait a few weeks to do this one so you can save up as many toilet rolls or kitchen roll tubes as you can!

Cut up the tubes into different sizes, create a sculpture using these – you may want to use glue to help stick them onto each other in weird and wonderful ways or you can always cut slits and slot them together.

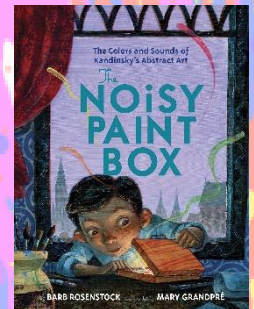


It would be great if you could decorate your sculpture.
