**Our theme this week is...**

# Investigate!

### Starters

**Being Imaginative:** Karaoke! Play your favourite music, learn the words of the song and sing along. Can you teach a grown up?

**Science:** When you have your bath, find out which objects float or sink. You could also use a sink.

Make a kite—what materials will you use and why? What weather is best for flying it?

**Art:** Shadow drawing— on a sunny day draw around the shadow of any object onto a piece of paper. How does it change throughout the day?

### Main Course

#### English:

Choose your favourite animal and use Google to make it 3D and appear in your home. Can you write a fact file about your animal?

Spring Soup—get a bowl of water and add some Spring nature finds. Can you write a list of the ingredients?

**Maths:** Find objects around your home or garden to make some patterns! Start as a simple ABAB pattern then challenge yourself to complete more complex patterns e.g fork, fork, knife.

Cut a piece of string to any length. Can you find things that are taller/shorter? Did you guess correctly?

**DT:** **Make a bird feeder**— follow the instructions on Cbeebies and make your own. Then watch to see which birds visit your garden or window.

Do you know the names of any of the birds that visit?

**Computing:** Write an email to your teacher to tell them what you have been doing. Maybe you can send a photo too. Your teacher will write back!

### Dessert

#### Speaking and Listening:

It can be hard not seeing friends and family— why not look at some photos with your grown-ups and talk about them.

#### Moving and Handling:

Build a comfy reading den or a fort— inside or outside using blankets. Make Ninja Warrior obstacle course. What can you use to travel over, under and through? Ask if you can use a grown-ups phone to time yourself. Can you improve your time?
