



**Our theme this week is...**

Knights!

**Starters**

**DT:** Create a moving flag for your knight. How can you make your flag move? What materials can you use to decorate your flag? Take your flag outside– does it move in the wind?

**Geography:** Find out some facts about a knight of your choice. Where in the world does this knight come from? Can you make a poster for your knight?

**Art:** Design a shield for your knight. What symbols will you use to represent your knight? What colours do you think would be important to your knight?

**Main Course**

**English:** Watch Alphablocks (found on Cbeebies, YouTube, BBC iPlayer)- this will support your child with their letter sounds and with blending and segmenting words for reading and spelling.

Write out a shopping list of all items you think a knight would need for their weekly shop! Don't forget to use your sounds to help you.

**Maths:** Watch Numberblocks (found on Cbeebies, YouTube, BBC iPlayer)- particularly episodes with numbers up to 20, halving, doubling, more and less, counting in 2's, 5's, 10's. Practise counting back from 20. This can be done through playing games such as hide and seek.

Practise writing out the digits 0-9. Look out the window and count how many houses or buildings can be seen.

**Computing:** Using the shapes on Microsoft word, make a knight out of the shapes! What shapes will make a good knight? Can you change the colour of the shapes? How can you move the shapes?

**Science:** Look around your house for a range of materials. Test which material would make the strongest shield for your knight.

**Speaking and Listening:** Talk about/ present your facts about your knight of choice to your family. Can your family guess where in the world your knight comes from?

**Moving and Handling:** Can you navigate yourself around an obstacle course in your house/garden? How can you change direction to avoid the obstacles?
