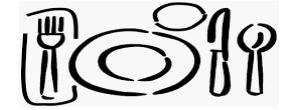




Week 5– Home Learning Menu– EYFS



Our theme this week is...

Spring!

Starters

Computing: Use google images to find pictures of Spring. Use your sounds to help you type in the word 'Spring' into the search engine. What do you like about the pictures?

Science: Go on a 'Spring Walk' and collect different items that remind you of Spring. Look at the items you collected, explore the textures. How do they feel? Are they smooth or bumpy? How do they feel different? How do they feel similar?

Art: Using the items from your 'Spring Walk' create a 'Spring Collage'. Think about the different materials you could use to stick your items down. Don't forget to give your lovely collage a title!

Main Course

English:

Read the story of Jack and the Beanstalk (or watch on youtube). What makes the Beanstalk grow?

Can you make your own bean grow and write a set of instructions?

Can you illustrate your instructions with lovely pictures?

Don't forget a title for your instructions!

Maths: Try some of the White Rose daily maths activities.

Look for numbers on any packaging you can find around the house. Can you recognise the number? Can you count out a matching amount?

Explore weighing and measuring food on the kitchen scales. What happens as you place more food on the scales?

DT: Using junk modelling from around your house, create your very own 'Spring Garden'. Think about which materials would be best to use for grass or flowers. How can you add colour to your 'Spring Garden'?

Geography: Choose any country and research what the weather is like in Spring. Is it different or similar to England's? What other facts can you find out?

Speaking and Listening: Play a Spring themed game of 'I Spy'. How can you describe the items? What questions can you ask to help you guess?

Moving and Handling: Explore different ways of moving. Can you hop like a bunny? Can you grow tall like a flower? Can you skip like a lamb? How would you splash in a puddle?
