Starters

Being Imaginative: Make a Tiny Food Monster! Here are some ideas





Science 1: Where does your food come from to start with? Does it come from a plant or an animal? Take a look in your kitchen cupboards and in the fridge...

Science 2: Food chains!

Think about what one of animals in your garden might eat and make a labelled food chain.

Literacy: Listen to this story

What did you like/dislike? Did anything surprise you? Could you design your own disgusting sandwich?
Write a little letter to your teacher.
Tell us what you've been up to... Have you been for a nice walk? Did you make something with lego?

Maths: Cooking or baking!

Ask your grownup if they can help you do some cooking or baking—maybe you could make chocolate crispy cakes?
Can you read the numbers on the recipe?
How many spoons of different ingredients do you need? How long will they take to make?

DT: Make your own sandwich! Ask your grownup to help you make a sandwich. It can be sensible or funny! Can you carefully cut or spread something on your sandwich?

Geography: Where in the world does your food come from?? With a grownup, have a look on the labels of your food. See if you can label a map showing where your food has come from. There is a map attached to this learning map that you could use. Do you notice any patterns?
