Starters

Main Course

Present your findings in an interesting way.

During the Victorian times, Britain ruled over many other countries. Use a blank map of the world (ask your teacher!) to show the British Empire. Research one of the countries. Create a presentation to show what you have found out.

Choose three times tables you find very difficult, and practice them in different ways. You could learn a song or draw a picture to help you remember!

Research a Victorian author or playwright. Find someone you are interested in, and make a short presentation about their work.
