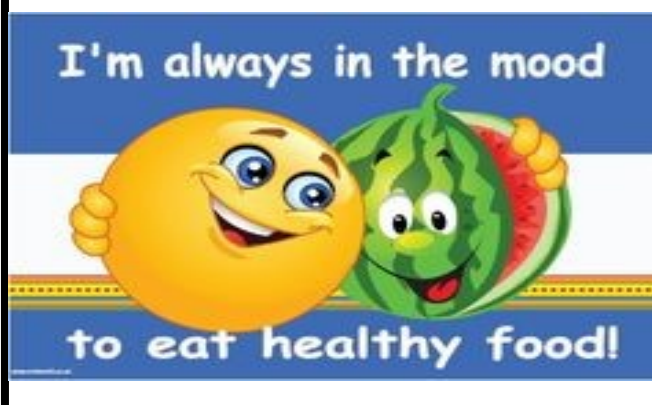
Headteachers' Message

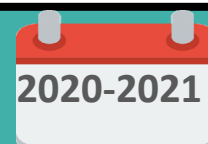
