What does it cost?

The cost per person is approximately £240 per person which can be paid in instalments prior to the trip. Pupils who wish to take part will have a booking made with the tour operator, by the school, on their behalf and it is understood that all conditions of the booking are as laid down by the tour operator. For example, deposits are non-refundable once they have been forwarded to the tour operator, except for cancellation due to medical reasons, confirmed by a doctor.

Insurance has been taken with PGL and we are currently finalising the travel arrangements. We have based the cost on the company's estimated ferry prices in May 2022 and as soon as travel arrangements can be finalised and the numbers attending confirmed we will advise of any change this makes to the total cost.
