How it works:

Week 1: Learn 15 words. Try to spell all 15 correctly in your test on Friday 26th April.

Week 2: Learn 15 new words. Try to spell all 15 correctly in your test on Friday 3rd May.

Week 3: Learn 15 more new words. Try to spell all 15 correctly in your test on Friday 10th May. The top 3 spellers in each class, who get the highest score out of 45, will go head-on to have a 'spell-a-thon' in class on Friday 10th May. Your teacher will ask you, one at a time, to spell a word from the list, out loud. If you are in the top 3 and you spell a word wrong, then you are out! **Once each class has narrowed down their 'top 1' class 'Spelling Bee Champion', then each 'top 1' from each class in the year group will go head-to-head in our 'Spelling Bee Competition' in our Friday school assembly.**

Week 4: We will invite your parents/carers to come to our Spelling Bee assembly at 8.55 on Friday 17th May, to watch each Class Spelling Champion go head-to-head. The Class Spelling Champions will then take turns in a verbal 'spell-a-thon', to see who the **overall Spelling Bee Champion** will be for each year group.

Are you good at finding ways to learn new spellings? Are you a super speller? Well here's your chance to become Brookfield's first ever Spelling Bee Champion for 2019! Good luck!!
