



Information for Parents/Carer

Arrival at School

Pupils should arrive at school between 8.45am and 8.55am (unless attending Breakfast Club). Prior to this teachers and TAs are preparing their classrooms for the school day. Children are to go straight into their class or the hall, where they will be given a short activity to complete before registration begins at 8.55am. If you arrive after 8.55am please send your child in to their room as quietly as possible so not to disrupt the class.

Late arrivals at School

A reminder that late arrivals in the morning are very disruptive to your child's class – your child needs your support to get to school before 8.55am. Any child who arrives after 9am should report to the office, then your child will be taken into their classroom by a member of staff.

Breakfast Club

The school has a successful breakfast club which runs from 8am to 8.45am, the cost per child is £2.00 without breakfast or £2.50 with breakfast of toast or cereal and a drink.

End of school day

School finishes at 3pm for Turtles and Seahorses and pupils should be collected from their own outdoor areas. Dolphins finish at 3.05pm and are sent out of the main entrance.

Collecting your child before the end of the school day

If you have a reason to collect your child during the school day ie a dental appointment, please inform the school in advance. On arrival go to the office and your child will be brought to reception for you.

After school clubs and childcare provision

Please see half termly letters regarding which activities are on offer. Provision is available to book in advance for pupils to be able to stay until 4.30pm or 5pm Monday – Thursday, bookable in half hourly slots at £2.00 per half hour.
