#### PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

The Children's Act has put a legal obligation on schools that means that we must record information which might be of a sensitive nature. We regret having to do this but assure you that your response will be treated in confidence.

The Children's Act 1989, as amended, defines who has parental responsibility for a child. In essence:

- The mother has responsibility automatically.
- The father has responsibility only if he and the mother were married (before or after the child's birth).
- **Another person** may be granted responsibility by the Courts, e.g. an unmarried father; grandparents with whom the child lives; if the child is in care.
- Under changes brought in from 1st December 2003, a father who was not married to the mother at the time of his child's birth automatically has parental responsibility if named (after this date) on the child's birth certificate.

The law has kept pace with the growing range of family scenarios, and provides means by which, for example, a step-parent or second parent in a civil partnership might gain parental responsibility.

Parental responsibility is permanent and cannot be lost except by death, adoption or Court Order.

An absent mother therefore retains parental responsibility even if the child is living elsewhere. An absent father therefore retains parental responsibility if the marriage breaks down and he is living elsewhere, or if named on the child's birth certificate (after 1<sup>st</sup> December 2003) and living elsewhere. One consequence of this for schools is that information sent to the caring parent must also be sent to the absent parent. It is the absent parent's legal right to receive such information. An absent parent's consent is required in order for a child's name to be changed. Governors are required to include the absent parent in any of their consultations with parents.

We need to record contact information for parents/carers/emergency contacts in case of need in relation to your child, and to ensure that all persons for whom we hold information have given their express consent to this, and understand how such information will be stored/used/shared.
