

Sithney School Pupil Attainment 2019

NB Please remain mindful that all year groups are small so in a year group of 12 pupils, 1 pupil is 8% and 2 pupils are 17%. This means that a small school can appear to be significantly below National data but it may only be by 1 pupil. Similarly, it may be impossible to be 'in line' with National data.

In 2019 our KS2 SATs results for working at expected are above National in reading and maths, just below National in GPS but below National in writing. For working at greater depth our KS2 SATs results are above National in writing and GPS and just below National for reading and maths. All our KS2 results for reading, writing and maths for working at expected and working at greater depth have improved from 2018 except for writing at expected, which has stayed the same.

Floor standard

A school will be above the floor if:

- at least 65% of pupils meet the expected standard in English reading, English writing and mathematics; or
- the school achieves sufficient progress scores in all three subjects: at least -5 in English reading, -5 in mathematics and -7 in English writing. To be above the floor, the school needs to meet either the attainment or the entire progress element.

Comparing schools with small pupil numbers

When comparing schools or colleges, you should consider that differences may not be significant if you're looking at a small year group. For example, if 1 pupil in a group of 10 fails to make expected progress, this will reduce figures by 10%, whereas in a group of 30 pupils, this would only reduce figures by 3%.

In 2019 our KS1 SATs results for working at expected are above National in reading and writing and below National in maths. For working at greater depth our KS1 SATs results are above National in maths and just in line with National in reading and writing. All our KS1 results for reading, writing and maths for working at expected and working at greater depth have improved from 2018.
