School Council Elections

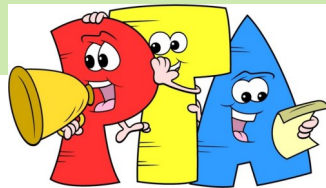

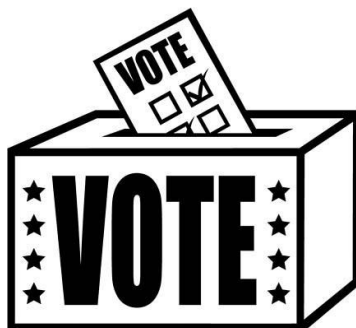


PTA Bag Pack
