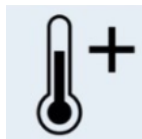
LIFEPATH YEAR 4: On Friday 18th June, Kirstine Davis will be coming to school to deliver Lifepath on the Road to Year 4. The event offers Year 4 pupils the opportunity to explore the Christian Faith through the "Lifepath" of a well known Christian from the local area. Lifepath has run at Brinkburn Priory in Northumberland since 2011 and over 500 children from schools across Northumberland usually attend the event, but this year is on the road. Lifepath is a whole school day and children take part in a variety of activities linked to one of the Northern Saints. Lifepath Brinkburn is run as a partnership between Mustard Tree Trust, Scripture Union, Barnabas in Schools and local Churches.
