

English/Literacy/C&L

We will start the term learning about onomatopoeia and thinking about what onomatopoeia words we can use to describe fireworks. We will be reading the story 'The Jolly Christmas Postman' and looking at the traditional fairy tales that are used within the story.

YR will continue to practise phonics every day and will be moving onto phase 3 sounds. They will be segmenting and blending the letter sounds to write CVC words as well as practising letter formation using jingles.

Y1 will be thinking about other onomatopoeia words that we use everyday as well as those used to describe fireworks.

There will be a huge emphasis on speaking and listening this term as all children develop their performance skills for the Nativity.

PSHE/PSED

During our PSHE sessions we will be following the theme 'celebrating difference'. We will be thinking about what we are good at, how we are special and unique, families and making friends.

Art, Design and Technology/EA&D

The Creation station is always stocked with various things for the children to use and make masterpieces. This term we will be making salt dough Christmas decorations.

Computing/U+W

Linking to our topic, Ash Class will be creating a map for the Jolly Postman to travel around. The children will program a Bee-Bot by inputting directions to make it move around the map

Music/EA&D

This term our music sessions will be focussed around learning songs for the Nativity.

Maths/Number & Shape, Space and Measure

YR: Throughout the term we will be matching numerals to the number in a set, saying the next number for any number up to 20, creating repeating patterns and describing 2D shapes.

Y1: will continue to practise counting forwards and backwards to 100. They will be learning odd and even numbers and doubles up to double 5. They will also be finding one more and one less than a given number as well as naming and describing the properties of 2D shapes.

Science/U+W

During our Science sessions we will be learning about seasonal changes and observing weather patterns. To observe the wind, we will make a wind toy so we can see which direction the wind is blowing. We will also be keeping a weather diary for one week in each of the seasons so we can compare them at the end of the year.

RE/U+W

Mrs Ryan will take Ash class for their RE sessions. Throughout the term they will be looking at what Christians believe God is like.

PE

Fundamental movement skills taught by Mr McCarthy on Wednesdays...but PE kit must be in every day.

Geography/U+W

Throughout the term we will be focussing on different land features and labelling diagrams to identify these features.
