

Juniper Term 1 2018-19 Curriculum Web

Maths Y6

We will be reading, writing, ordering and comparing numbers up to 10,000,000 and determining the value of each digit. We will be rounding whole numbers and using negative numbers in context and calculating intervals across zero. We will be securing calculations involving all four number operations and solving problems involving all of the above.

Art

We will be looking at Vincent van Gogh's 'Sunflowers' and studying the work of Lowry, who is famous for his distinctive style of painting and is best known for his urban landscapes peopled with human figures often referred to as "matchstick men".

PE

Acorn coaches will be delivering specialist PE teaching this term on the topic of Football. We are also swimming this term.

PSHE:

Our Jigsaw PSHE unit is *Being Me in My World*. We'll be exploring our rights and responsibilities as British citizens, rewards and consequences of behavior choices and the benefits of having a democracy.

Languages

We will be focusing on speaking and listening involving existing and learnt German vocabulary and then learning to write these words and phrases.

English Y6

Writing – We will be looking at Clock work by Philip Pullman and innovating our own fantasy stories based on the themes and characters in the story.

SPAG – We will focus on word classes, types of noun, expanded noun phrases, adverbials, synonyms and antonyms.

Reading Comprehension – We will continue to work on examining vocabulary and answering comprehension and inference questions using the Bug Club resources.
