All ages	Learning Logs will run across the whole term (to the date set by the teacher). Work will be brought in to be shared in class on a Friday afternoon. It is hoped that over the course of the term a good learner will have produced 2 or 3 pieces to share. Of course if your child wishes to do more – propelling their learning - then that is terrific!

Each week the teacher will inform the children which task is to be done (it might always follow in order). The recommended time is 30mins for the Reading Comprehension and Maths – so it is ok not to finish. Please bear in mind, however, that these tasks have been designed to take this long and so the more often your child does not finish the higher the potential for them to fall behind their peers and not work at Age Related Expectations.

Regular reading as a parent with your child is essential for their development. Please record this in their Reading Record, as has always been the case. They will earn points towards their Reading Olympiad!

The (OPTIONAL) Ninja Maths booklets are there if you would like to support your child with their maths fluency. These core arithmetic skills are essential knowledge your child will need in order to have the confidence to work at Age Related Expectations. We would recommend you use one objective and do a daily practice (there are 10 daily practices per objective). This is your choice.

At a time when, in many schools parents are being asked to pay for many essential learning resources, I am sure you will highly value and respect the significant investment St John's is making towards your child's home learning. Please note that we will not replace lost or damaged booklets – parents will be expected to purchase replacements.
