

Summer Term 2019 Curriculum

Maths

This term will begin with a focus on measurement and data interpretation. This will involve measuring, recording and reading scales for volume, mass, temperature and length. After this, we will be constructing, reading and interpreting data from bar graphs, pictograms and timetables. We will conclude with more recapping of this year's learning involving the four main operations and some fractions. KS1 must be fluent in 2x, 3x, 5x and 10x tables in order to solve multiplications and divisions, and being able to see the link between the two. Please keep practicing these!

Science

Changing Seasons

- Exploring the 4 seasons and their associated weather patterns
- Looking at the changes within each season and the months in which they occur
- Understanding how the length of the day changes as we move through the seasons.
- Measuring wind and rain with homemade devices.

English

Pine class will begin with writing newspaper reports based on an amazing event that has happened involving their superhero character made during half term. This will be followed by a fiction unit based on the story of The Three Little Superpigs. Pine class will write their own version of this story, inventing their own superpig powers and events surrounding the wolf. There will be a big emphasis on handwriting and spelling this term to ensure that the children are ready for Year 2 and 3 after the summer. This must be practiced lots!



PSHE

Changing Me

We will be looking at how our bodies change as we get older and how they are different to others. Respecting differences between us and knowing how to look after ourselves will also be an important part of this.
