

Summer Term 2019 Curriculum

Maths

This term will begin recapping previous learning from the beginning of this year. The main focus will be on the four operations of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

Year 1 will focus on using number facts to add and subtract quickly whereas Year 2 will continue practicing adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers. KS1 must be fluent in 2x, 3x, 5x and 10x tables in order to solve multiplications and divisions, and being able to see the link between the two. Please keep practicing these!

Fractions will also be revisited this term; finding half (& 2 quarters), quarter, three quarters and thirds of numbers.

Science

Materials

- Exploring different materials and their properties
- Testing strength, absorbency and water repellence of materials
- Identifying best materials to make a shelter from, with consideration of all material properties.

English

Man on the Moon will be the focus story this term. After exploring the book, Pine class will write their own space themed stories from the perspective of an alien! We will also do some factual writing on the first moon landing and the life of Neil Armstrong.

Focus remains on spelling, punctuation, writing sentences to include detail and working towards writing longer pieces.

This term will also include more reading comprehension tasks so please keep enjoying stories with the children at home!

Relationships

We will be looking at the variety of relationships we have with various people, how they are different and how we can maintain healthy relationships through friendship, love and respect for all.
