

Owl Class (Base 5) Learning: Term 6

Morning Activities:

We'll continue to work on revision activities in English and maths first thing in the morning, but we might also use this time to work on elements of our production.

Reading:

Our Bug Club sessions will continue and we will be encouraging the children to assess and mark their partner's work. As always, we'll be looking for detailed answers that link well to the text.

Maths:

We'll continue to work on shape at the start of our final term. We'll then move on to learn about position and direction (such as reflection and translation). Next we'll be working on converting units of measure and then estimating and comparing volume and capacity. To finish the term, we'll revisit any areas of maths from the year that we found particularly tricky.

English:

In SPAG we'll focus on the present perfect tense and past perfect tense, then tools to link paragraphs. Our spelling/vocabulary focus will be on idioms, antonyms and revisiting spelling rules covered throughout the year.

This term we will finish off our work on persuasive letters and then move on to examine a non-fiction text. This will most likely be in the style of a guide or handbook, with the children producing their own piece. To finish the term and link with the Year 5/6 production, we'll be working on play scripts.

Please come in and see me if you have any questions about your child's class work or homework. Thank you for supporting your child's learning throughout the year. In this final term, I ask you to continue to encourage your child to check their written work for mistakes and see if they can ask/solve word problems using maths skills we've covered (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, percentages, fractions and decimals). In addition, any support in helping your child prepare for the Year 5/6 play will be gratefully received.
