

English/Literacy/C&L

Year R: This term we will start by reading and recognising our names and writing them, remembering where to start and finish our letters. We will also begin learning new letter sounds in Phase 2 phonics. Once we have learnt the first few sounds we will then begin to practise segmenting and blending words and writing them.

Year 1: We will be looking at different books about travel and transport and reading stories about journeys. We are going to be labelling different transport and writing a postcard form somewhere our story has taken us.

PSHE/PSED

During our PSHE sessions we will be following the theme 'Being me in my world'. We will be thinking about what the different emotions are and how they make us feel.

Maths/Number & Shape, Space and Measure

YR: The term will start with lots of counting forwards and backwards and matching numerals to objects.

We will practise 1:1 counting, matching our finger to the object we are counting. We will also start to find the total number of objects in a group by counting.

Y1: We will start the term counting forwards and backwards to 100 and reminding ourselves of the different operation signs and what they mean. We will be using the addition and subtraction sign to work out calculations.
