

**AIRE CLASS** - This week our main focus has been Sennen Farmers' Market. We enjoyed chatting to the stall-holders during our visit on Tuesday, as we gathered photos and information to use in our pictures and poems. These will be displayed as part of the market's 10th anniversary celebrations. We also enjoyed learning about using paper, glass and other containers instead of plastic, with the children thinking more about this on Wednesday: plastic-free day. We bought different foods at the market for tasting back at school: always a hit! In Maths, we continue our half-termly focus on numbers to 20 for Reception children, and simple multiplication and division for the Year 1's, using natural materials for our maths objects this week. Our bean and potato plants are growing well, and we have managed to spend some time in our lovely garden. Next week we will finish our poems and pictures, and continue to think more about grouping objects and simple division. We will also be visiting Penlee Museum and Art Gallery on Thursday.

**BRISONS CLASS** - The children have finished their 'Egyptian Cinderella' stories. We have been using ambitious vocabulary, similes and exclamation sentences to improve our writing. In Maths we have continued our learning on fractions. The children have been extremely resourceful this week and are really using the classroom environment to further their learning. We have had our final dance workshop and we are very excited about our performance on Monday. Please remember to bring your costumes to school to change into, these are optional, but it would be wonderful if all children were wearing something that fits the theme 'superhuman me' in their performance. The children have produced beautiful still life art to help celebrate the farmers market.

Everyone really enjoyed participating in plastic free day. They have learnt about ways they can help protect the ocean and wildlife. We have started a class display using recycled materials and are hoping to promote not only going plastic free, but to recycle, reduce and reuse as much as possible. **BRISONS LEARNING LEGEND** Ethan for having an amazing work ethic and for being so positive with everything he does.

**COWLOE CLASS** - This week, the Year 4 and 5 children have been looking at ways we can improve our school tuck shop. The children have been surveyed and are looking at healthy options and ways we can reduce the use of plastic packaging. The children have really enjoyed taking charge of this and we will shortly be discussing how we can implement this effectively. We have started our new science topic this week and the children used string, torches and mirrors to explain how light travels and behaves. They were even shut in a dark cupboard to show that we need light to see! We have also continued our Keen to be Green topic by researching the benefits of plastic as well as the negative impact of plastic. As you know, the year 6 children have their SATS next week. I would like to say thank you to you all for your support with the children. They have been showing great resilience these past few weeks with their revision and I am really proud of them all. There will be breakfast provided for them Monday to Thursday from 8.15am. I have told the children to make sure they relax and have a good weekend! **COWLOE LEARNING LEGEND** is Amber.
