

AIRE CLASS - This week's highlight was the visit to Sennen Church on Tuesday. These included dressing up in special robes and baptising a teddy bear! The children also enjoyed the beach safety talk by the lifeguards and produced some colourful pictures while absorbing the safety messages. We have been able to get into the garden, with activities linked to our Plants topic, while our potato and bean plants are starting to grow. In Maths, Reception children have been working hard to understand 1 more and 1 less than 20. Year 1 children continue to work hard on multiplication, using apparatus and pictures. They have been learning doubles and times tables facts. Next week our Art and English work will be inspired by a visit to Sennen Farmers' Market, as we prepare to celebrate the market's 10th anniversary with them. In Maths, we will all be grouping and sharing objects, with the Year 1 children learning to record these in different ways.

BRISONS CLASS - The children have had fun exploring the book 'Egyptian Cinderella,' using drama to learn the original story and adapting it to create a new version. We enjoyed practising our Minack Performance in the sunshine and the children have shown such superb teamwork. The children have concluded their science investigation into what plants need to grow well. We've planted tomato seeds inside and have begun planting in our outside area. We're very much hoping for enough to have a picnic before the summer

holidays!
