

Once upon a time



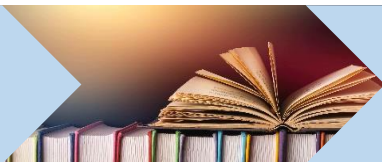
In this topic we will be covering traditional and alternative fairy tales as well as designing our own shields and creating fairy tale pictures.

MUSIC



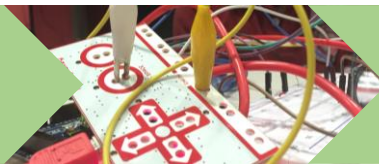
As musicians we will be listening to a variety of music and linking these with feelings and emotions.
