We are looking to appoint a Site Supervisor. The successful candidate will be responsible for the day to day repairs and maintenance of the school site, both internally and externally. A working knowledge of compliance and health and safety in a school environment would also be advantageous, although full training will be provided. They will work closely with the Head Teacher and School Business Manager, and will be expected to play a role in the school's journey to achieving 'Outstanding' with Ofsted.

The post will be 20 hours per week, all year round, commencing as soon as possible. The post is subject to a 3-month probationary period. The salary is Grade 5, points 11-14, salary £21,748 - £23,080 pro rata (actual salary £11,754 - £12,474 fte 0.5405). Working hours per day to be agreed with the Head Teacher.
