- Your child is welcome to start attending the Pre-School as soon as they turn two. You can book your child into as many sessions as we can accommodate.
- The rate for 2 year olds is £4.70 per hour, 3 & 4 year olds £4.16 per hour.

Once your child is eligible for early years funding the first 15 hours per week, up to a maximum of 570 per academic year, is free of charge to you. Anything over 15 hrs per week or over the total allowance of 570 hours per academic year will be charged at a rate of £4.16 per hour. You may be eligible for 30 hrs funding. To check your eligibility, visit www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. If you are eligible please provide us with your eligibility code and National Insurance for verification.

We are a registered 2 year old funding provider; please visit www.devon.gov.uk/twoyearoldfunding to check eligibility or phone Devon County Council on [0345 155 1013](tel:03451551013) if you think you qualify and have not received a Golden Ticket for your 15 hours of funded sessions for your two year old.

Early Years Funding

From the term after your child turns three, your child will become eligible for up to 15 or 30 hours of Early Years Entitlement Funding:
