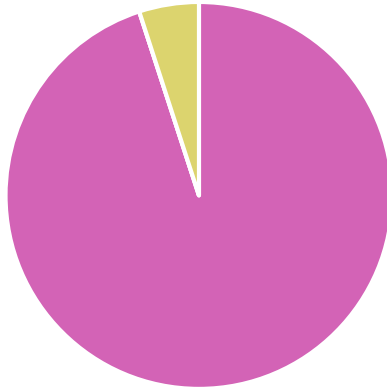


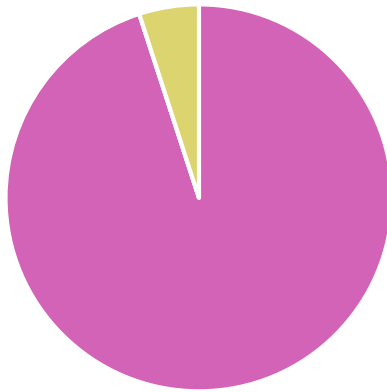

**My Child is Happy at School**



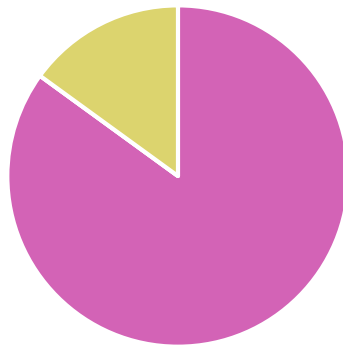

**2. My Child feels Safe at this School**



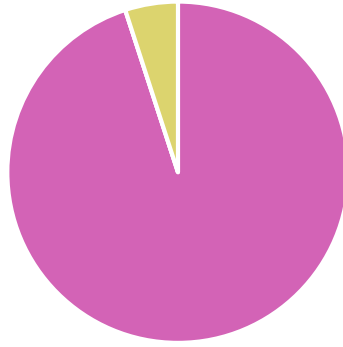

**3. The School Makes Sure it's Pupils are Well Behaved**



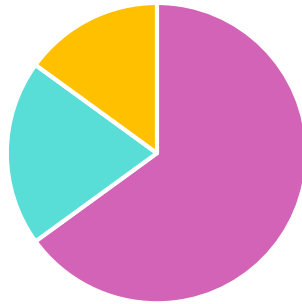

4. The School has made me Aware of what my Child will Learn During the Year.



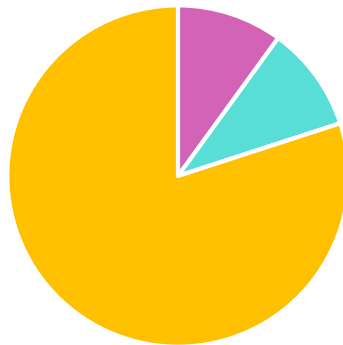

5. When I have Raised Concerns with the school, the have been dealt with effectively.



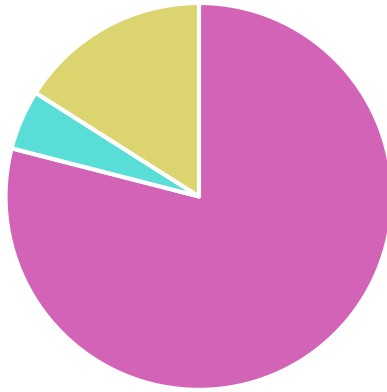

6 & 7. My Child has SEND and the School Gives them the Support they need to Succeed.



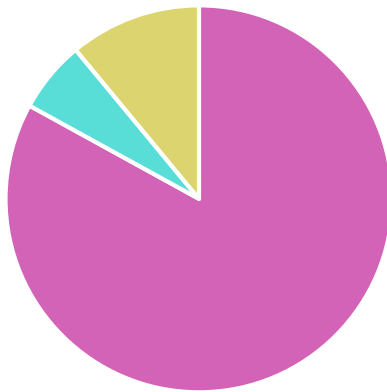

### 8. The School Has High Expectations of my Child



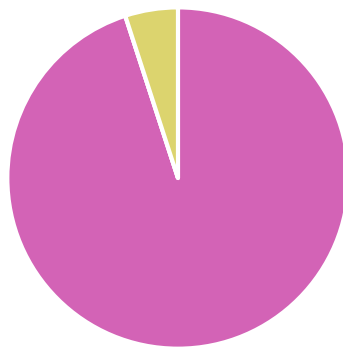

### 9. My Child does well at this School



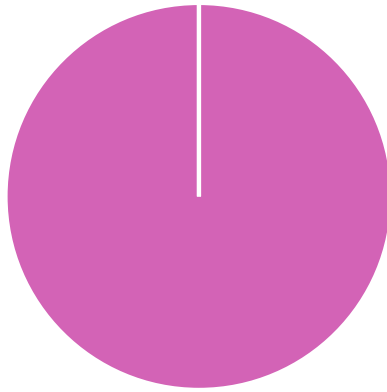

### 10. The School lets me know how my Child is Doing



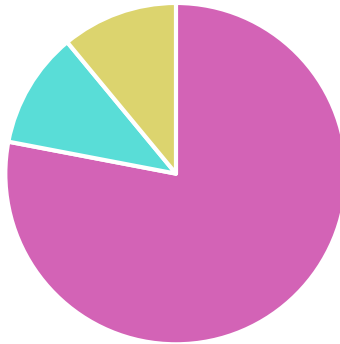

### 11. School Curriculum is Varied and Enriched



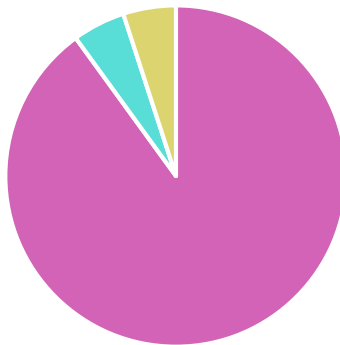

### 12. My Child can take part in Clubs and Activities at this School



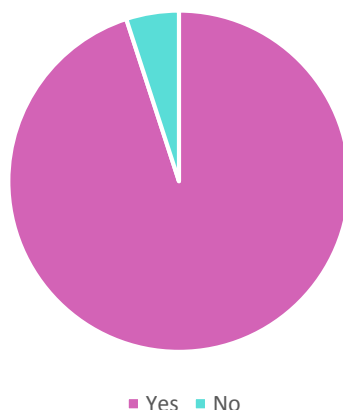

#### Comments

*'My son is much happier and gaining far more academically since being in Kings Nympton. This is because it is such a small school. The staff are so lovely and he enjoys going to school.'*

*'The only safety issue I would like to raise is, the top school gate, as I feel that it is too easy for any child to open and just walk out.'*

*'Ensuring pupils are well behaved in school is a joint effort, parents hold as much responsibility as the school, the school ensures that good behaviour is encouraged.'*

*'It would be nice to have more information given to parents about the work that the children are learning, ie. Maths sheets explaining what areas are being taught.'*

*'When I have raised concerns with the school my concerns have, I feel, been listened to and I go away feeling the suggestions made to address my concerns sound promising but then following that I feel that the promises are not followed through.'*

*'If we aren't given a target that our child is expected to meet then how do we know if their expectations are high?'*

*'I think she does but it's hard to know day-to-day, week-to-week how she is getting on. We are informed if we ask personally and at parents evening. I understand it's hard for teachers to talk to every parent. I feel confident that if there are any problems the teachers will contact me to discuss anything.'*

*'We are given a termly report as well as an opportunity a couple of times a year to meet with our child's teacher.'*

*'I hear about the odd club, but a breakfast and/or after school club would be hugely appreciated from the perspective of working parents.'*

*'No sporting fixtures have been offered in the last twelve months – when we have traditionally excelled in this area. Really disappointing for the children not to have a chance to have a 'team' feeling at fixtures that could be encouraged.'*

We are delighted that the overwhelming majority of parents feel that we are providing a high quality education for their children in an environment where they feel safe. We have welcomed comments containing suggestions for areas of improvement – some of which we have addressed and explained below.

Whilst we are pleased that most of the respondents are satisfied with the way we reply to concerns that have been raised, a small number feel that there is still work to be done in this area. We have set up a Parent Forum and welcome any comments so that we can continue a dialogue between the school and parents. Going forwards, your child's class teacher is always your first port of call should you wish to raise a concern. If you are not satisfied with the response you receive, please make an appointment with Mrs. Fenemore, the executive head.

We are pleased that you have noticed the introduction of clubs this term. It is worth pointing out that after school clubs rely on the availability of staff. At this time, we are unable to set up breakfast or afterschool provision as this would require a separate budget and would have to be self-sustaining. With regards to sporting fixtures, we are in the process of identifying possibilities in the community around Kings Nympton as transport is an issue. This half term, there has been a Tag Rugby tournament and we have more fixtures being organised. These fixtures are reliant on a member of staff being available to supervise the children at these events.

With regards to your child's learning, there are curriculum overviews on the school's website. We have also introduced open sessions for parents to visit and share their children's learning twice a term. After Christmas, there will be a weekly overview of learning as part of the school newsletter to go alongside termly reports, class newsletters, and two parents evenings a year.
