Communication, Language and Literacy

Skills:

- To continue to consolidate Phase 2 sounds and segment and blend words containing Phase 2 sounds.
- To begin to learn Phase 3 sounds.
- To write words and sentences using sounds we've learnt.
- To explore and retell stories using words, pictures, story maps and drama.

Understanding the World

- We will investigate and explore transport, our feelings, robots, sounds and adventures through a weekly key text.
- We will explore questions such as: Which materials are best to create a boat that floats? What should we do if we have a worry? What are nocturnal animals?

- To add and subtract quantities using part whole models
- To understand the concept of 0
- To consolidate number bonds to 5
- To explore numbers 6, 7, 8 and 9

- We will encourage children to go outside and be active in their gardens or on walks in the local area.
