

## Daily Reading While at Home

It is very important that children continue to read for at least 30mins a day so can still make steady progress in all areas of their learning. In addition to regular daily reading there are lots of fun online reading activities the children can enjoy.

Below is information on the activities the children are familiar with at school. All but one can be accessed on devices with a web browser and one has a free downloadable app. All usernames, passwords and addresses are in your child's reading record or planner.

Children in years 2-6 use Accelerated Reader by Renaissance Learning every day and are very familiar with how it works. They enjoy logging in to take book and literacy quizzes on books they have read, check their progress towards personal targets, look back on all the books and quizzes they have completed and check their new book recommendations. It is important that once the children have finished their book they remember to quiz within 24 hours.
