A balance remains for those children who are admitted throughout the year and require strategic interventions. It also allows any extra support holistically and academically for disadvantaged children who need may need it.

IMPACT OF SUPPORT

Continued embedding of previous and new interventions has proven extremely positive. The introduction of a Home School Link worker has raised the profile of pupil premium children and provided home-support to facilitate the needs of both children and their parents. Breakfast club has also offered an excellent starting point, grounding pupils in readiness for the school day.

The biggest focus area, this year, has been the need to increase progress and attainment through targeted and streamlined interventions. These interventions have had a direct impact on the increased percentages for Pupil Premium children. All figures and percentages are kept within school.
