Week 10 –

Rule: ‘-il’ at the end of words.

Rule: Adding ‘-es’ to nouns and verbs ending in consonant-letter–y.

Rule: Adding –ed to root words ending in consonant-letter–y.

copied, cried, replied.

Word List –October, November, December.

Week 1 –

Rule: Adding –ing to root words ending in consonant-letter–y.

copying, crying, replying.

Word List – they're, there, their.

Week 2 –

Rule: Adding –er to root words ending in consonant-letter–y.

copier, happier.

Word List – Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter.

Week 3 –

Rule: Adding –est to root words ending in consonant-letter–y.

happiest, prettiest, busiest.

Word List – where, wear, were.

Week 4 –

Rule: Adding the endings –ing and –ed, to words ending in vowel-letter–consonant-letter–e.

hiking, hiked.

Word List – here, hear.

Week 5 –

Rule: Adding the endings –er and –est, to words ending in vowel-letter–consonant-letter–e.

Rule: Adding the ending -y, to words ending in vowel-letter–consonant-letter–e.
