RE - This week in RE we have assimilated all that we have learnt over the topic to create our own class worship based on the Beatitudes, psalms and parables discussed in this topic. The children worked really hard on this and we had a very reflective and poignant class worship.

Science - In science we moved on to look at the circulatory system which is made up of the systemic and pulmonary systems. Maths (Due Wednesday)

Division - We have revisited short division this week and learnt how to find decimal remainders. We have also looked at how to divide up to 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers.

This week's homework is revising rounding from earlier this half term. Remember to look at the next digit - eg. If rounding to the nearest hundred, look at the next digit (the tens)

Literacy (Due Wednesday)

In English the children have written their final argument and debate text. They used the language conventions and grammar rules taught and produced some excellent writing!

In SpAG, we have learnt the difference between the active and passive voice by identifying the position of the subject, object and verb in a sentence. Remember... **verb = the doing/action**, **subject = who or what is doing the verb**, **object = who/what is having the verb done to it**. Active = S V O and Passive = O V S
