Social Distancing Measures at Nansledan

Thank you all for your commitment to helping us ensure a safe school environment for everyone at the beginning and end of the school day. Our improved one-way system has made things much safer for pedestrians.

With infection rates rising nationally, it is more important than ever to ensure social distancing on site. With this in mind, the following rules apply:

- Maintain the 2m distance from all other households and staff throughout your time on site.
- If there is a build-up ahead of you, please queue at 2m distances from each other.
- Follow the one-way system.
- Do not stop for a conversation with staff or each other. Instead, keep the flow!
- Parking – No parking on Chapel Lane
- Keep your children with you for the duration of your walk around the one-way system.
- Stick to your allocated time-slot. Being early is not a good thing at this time!

We will consider further changes if these control measures do not go far not enough to ensure social distancing.
