CENSUS DAY – THURSDAY 16th JANUARY

Census day is when the DfE collects information about each school to help them plan for the future, and most importantly, the data is used to set future school budgets. One of the figures we have to report is the number of meals taken in Reception, Years 1 and 2 on this day. This data will then be used to decide how much funding for the year for our hot meals. We only receive enough funding for meals taken on census days. Our solution is to ask every child in Reception, Years 1 and 2 to try a hot meal on Census Day. Then your child will be fully funded to have during the year thus saving the school any additional costs.
