### Skol Nansledan Nursery & Class Structure

We started off with 5 classes in September 2019 but expanded to 6 in November. We are now looking forward to our new Reception pupils joining us in September 2020 and our numbers increasing as pupils move up through school. As a result of this, we will be expanding to 8 classes in September, as follows:

EYFS - Two classes Year 1 - Two classes

Year 2 - One class Year 3/4 - Two mixed classes

Year 5/6 - One class

The pandemic has complicated and slowed down a number of processes, one of which is the planned development of our Nansledan Nursery. We can confirm that this is not likely to be ready to open to pupils until September 2021.

While we are still in the process of recruiting staff members and gathering information on new pupils we're unable to finalise staffing arrangements and the children's classes just yet. We will ensure you are fully informed once decisions are finalised.
