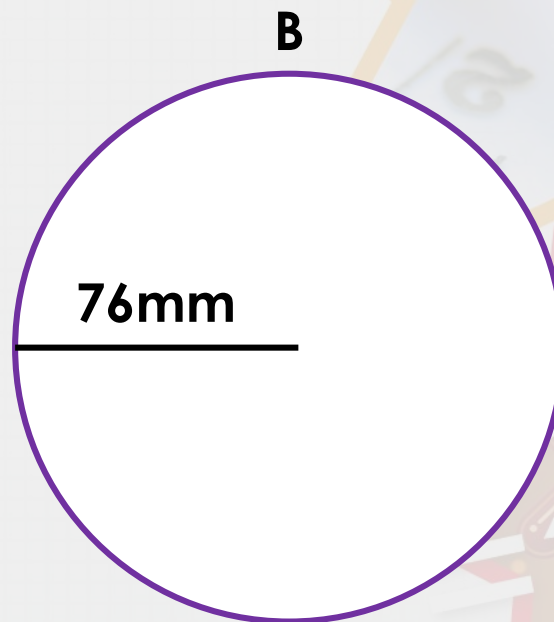
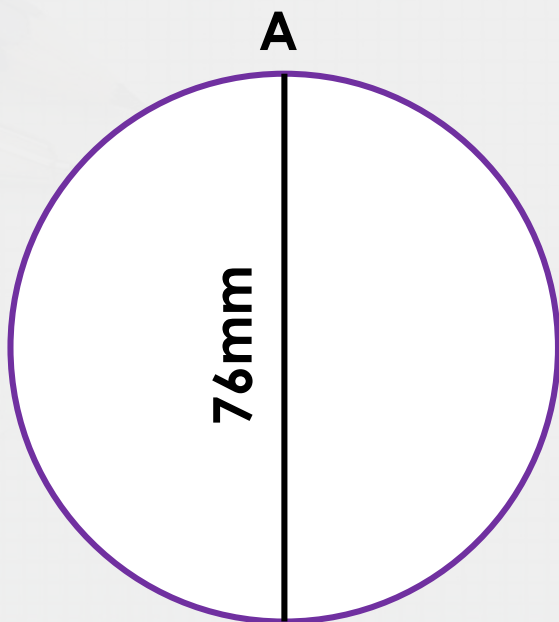

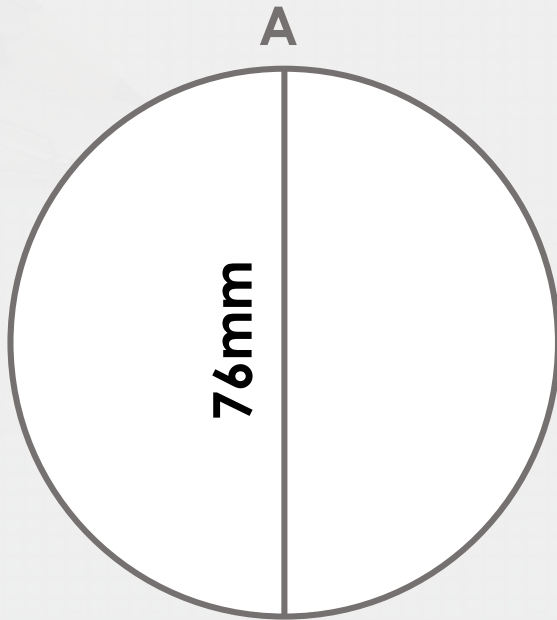
Varied Fluency 1

Tick the circle which has a radius of 76mm. *Remember that the radius is the measurement from the centre of a circle to its edge.*

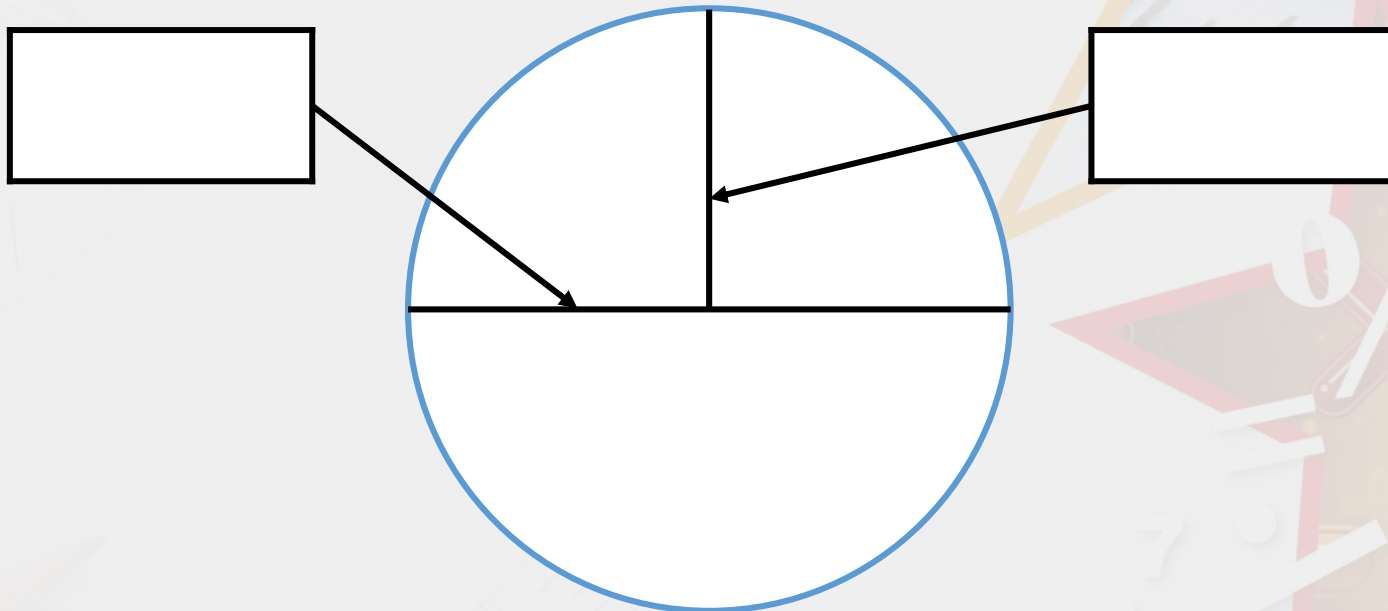


Varied Fluency 2

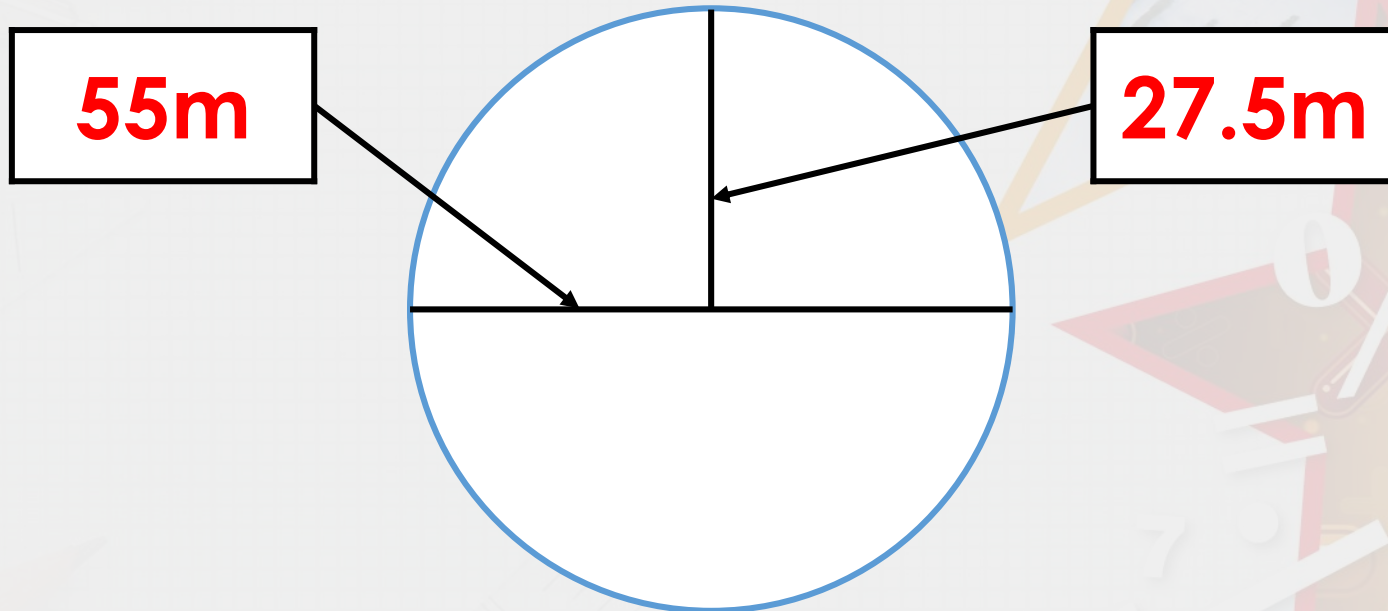


## Varied Fluency 2

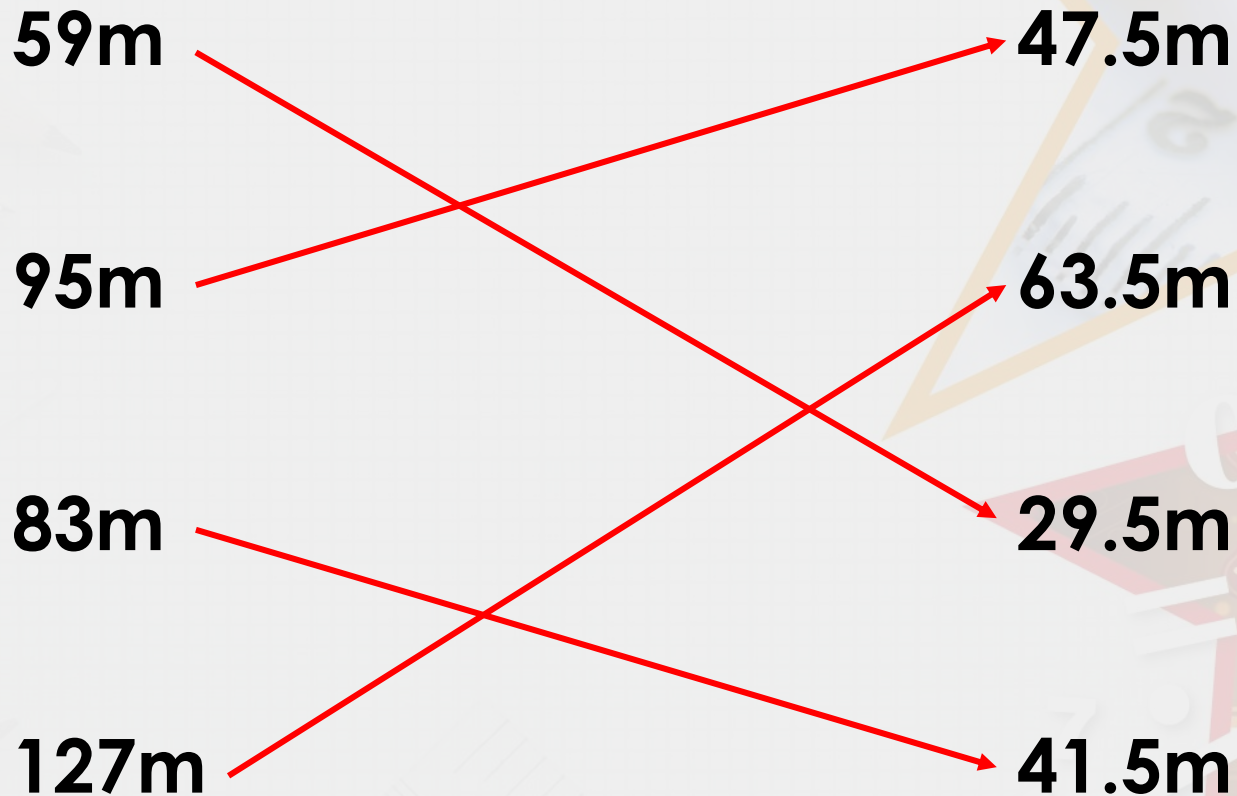

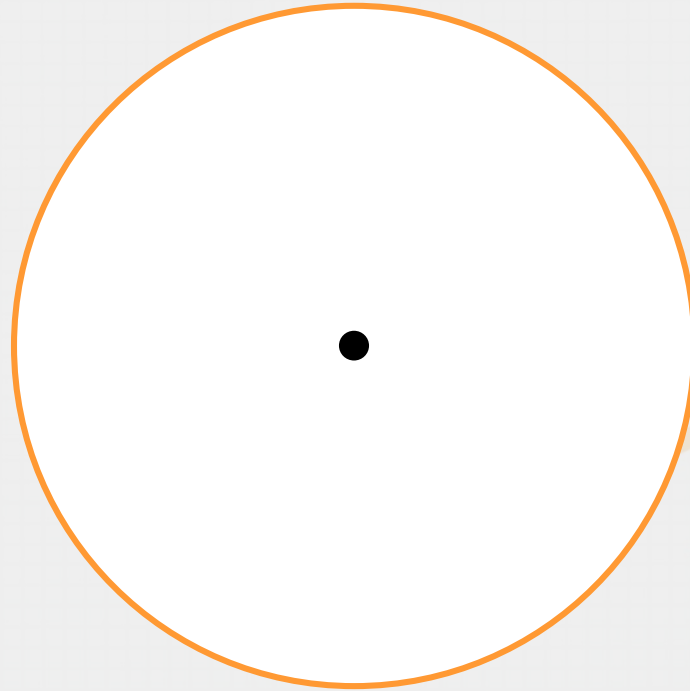

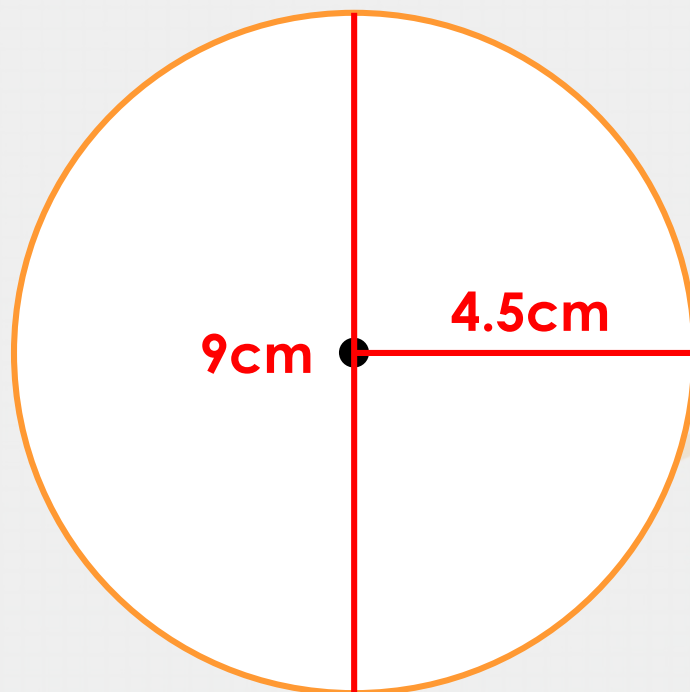
