

Top Tips for Parents Using Google Classroom

As a parent/carer, I will be expected to do the following in the event of remote learning taking place or virtual meetings are held:

Expectations

1. I will be dressed appropriately as if I were meeting my child's teacher in school
2. Help my child in setting up the device to access remote learning
3. DO NOT take pictures or videos of the screen
4. Have set up the laptop or tablet in a suitable place before we join a live meeting (**there are no inappropriate things in my background and make sure my child or I am comfortable**).
5. Ensure that there are no inappropriate sounds in the background before unmuting myself, i.e. language, music, TV programmes.



- Log in 5-10 mins before any live meeting to ensure all my technology is working
- If necessary, blur my background
- If possible, join meeting in a quiet room
- Be respectful of others
- Use a laptop or mobile device to access the virtual meeting

- DO NOT take photos or videos of other people on the screen (this includes recording the conversation on your device)
- DO NOT try and access any other virtual classroom other than those that your children are part of

Any verbal abuse or negative comments towards a teacher during live "Meets" will result in the virtual appointment being immediately terminated and reported to the headteacher.
