Physical Education Rationale

At Hambrook Primary School, we believe in the development of sport and physical activity for all pupils so that participation and achievement levels can continue to rise. We have liaised with staff and children, encouraging collaboration and partnership, to make the best use of resources to enhance PE and sport provision throughout Hambrook. We believe it is important for children to experience participation in a wide range of team sports and be successful in a range of sporting disciplines.

This plan aims to structure raising standards of teaching throughout the school and support further opportunities for all pupils in a range of physical activity, both during the school day and out of school hours.


Our aims for this academic year have been based on the following criteria:

1. Engage pupils in a wide range of sporting disciplines
2. Motivate all children to achieve their potential
3. Specifically target and put in place interventions to support children with their physical literacy
4. Support teachers with resources and equipment to deliver outstanding PE
5. Continue to develop teacher confidence in the delivery of outstanding PE

How have we spent the Sports Premium funding?

Careful planning has been carried out to ensure the sports premium funding is used to enhance the current provision for physical education. We have taken into consideration the guidelines set out by the government, the Youth Sport Trust and our Local Authority to ensure our funding is spent appropriately and effectively. This also includes careful consideration of the 5 Key Indicators that are laid out below which help schools measure their impact.

What has been the impact so far?

At the half way point through this academic year, the impact of our investment is clear. Bristol Sport are continuing to deliver and support curriculum PE lessons within our school. This is helping teachers deliver a wide range of sporting disciplines confidently and it is also improving their knowledge of delivering a sequence of lessons within a unit. This will ensure children are exposed to learning fundamental skills, applying these skills and then using these skills across multiple situations whilst making important decisions tactically within team games.

Children's awareness of their development in PE is increasing and their engagement across the whole school has improved significantly. We regularly celebrate sporting successes at our weekly celebration assembly.

The increased exposure to competitive sport is also having an immense impact on our children and teachers. This additionally helps promote sport within our school and outside in our local community.

Primary PE and Sport Premium - Key Indicators

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer. There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school
2. The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increased participation in competitive sport
