### UK Road Safety Rules for Children

- Always walk on a pavement or footpath if there is one.
- Walk on the right hand side of the road (facing oncoming traffic) if there is no pavement.
- Groups should walk in single file when there is heavy traffic, around bends, and at night.
- Take extra care crossing cycle lanes because bicycles are more difficult to see and not as noisy as other traffic.



### Cycling Safely

1. Wear your helmet. ...
2. Keep your head up and look ahead, not at the ground. ...
3. One person per bike. ...
4. Ride in single file with space between bikes.
5. Ride on the right side of the road, never against traffic. ...
6. **Plan** ahead if you will ride in a group

## The SAFE code

Keep SAFE around water, learn the code:

### SPOT

#### Spot the dangers

Check for hazards such as tides or currents  
Consider what could be hidden under the water  
Be careful of unsafe banks; stay well back from the edge

### ADVICE

#### Take advice

Always read the signs  
Only swim where there is a lifeguard  
Wear buoyancy aids and life jackets

### FRIENDS

#### Go with a friend

Swim with your friends and family  
Friends can get help  
Never swim alone

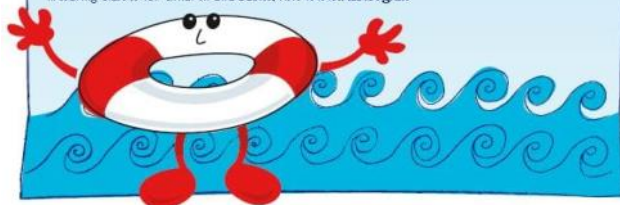
### EMERGENCY
