Application for a Primary School Place – even if already in Minpins

Parents of all children whose date of birth is between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 need to apply for a school place for their child **even if their child is already attending Minpins**. Applications should be made online using the Cornwall Council website www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions or by printing the paper form available online or from the School Admissions Team (0300 1234 101). If you would like assistance in completing your application please speak to the staff in Minpins or the school office. **The deadline for applications is 15th January 2020.**

Application for a Secondary School Place – Year 6 only

If you have a child in Year 6, it is important that you make an application for your preferred choice of secondary school starting in September 2020. Please register your preference online at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions or complete a paper form available online or from the School Admissions Team (0300 1234 101). If you have any concerns about this or would like assistance please pop into the office and we will arrange to help you complete the application. **The deadline for applications is 31st October 2019.**
