Parking

We have had several complaints from parents and residents about inconsiderate and dangerous parking around the school in recent weeks. In some cases, cars have been parked on pavements, blocking crossings so that children have to step onto the road to get past. This has been reported to the police who we have asked to monitor the situation.

Please can we also ask that anyone parking in the main school car park to collect children waits until the area is clear to manoeuvre out of spaces.

Under no circumstances should vehicles be turning in front of the barriers as this causes another hazard to children trying to cross safely. Please use the mini roundabout at the end of the road.

Extra parking is available at Victory Hall, a short walk away, and we urge parents to use this whenever possible.
