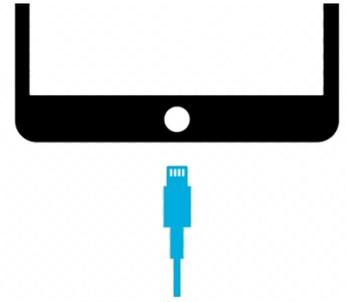

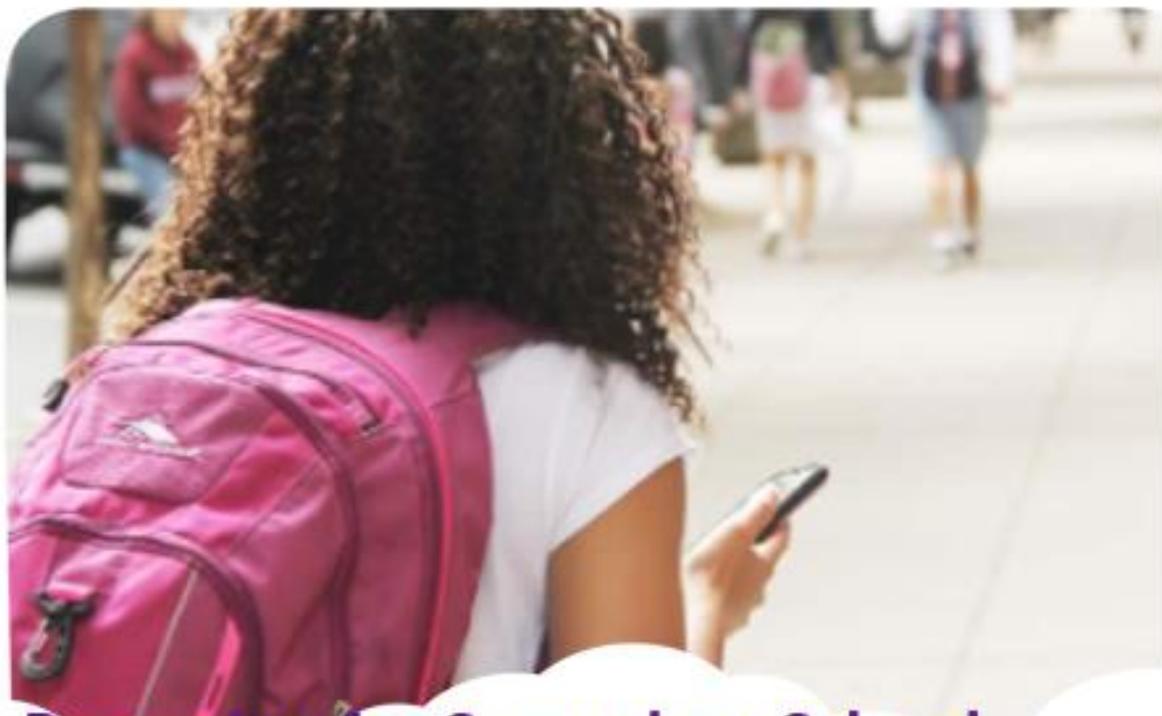

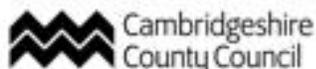
A workshop outlining ideas for supporting your child with the transition from primary to secondary school, looking at resources available to help and how and when to request support from the Early Help team.
