COVID concerns

Recently we are seeing larger numbers of bubbles and whole schools having to close this week in Cambridgeshire due to the spread of the Deltas variant of COVID. The widely known symptoms of **high temperature, persistent cough and loss of taste and smell** still signal a COVID infection. New symptoms of the Delta variant are:

Headache

Runny nose

Sore throat

If your child displays any of the above symptoms please book a PCR test (Not a lateral flow home test). You must then stay at home until you send school a copy of your negative result from the NHS.
