Read the CVC word and try and find the picture - this is tricky so ask an adult to help you. Try and remember some of the letters you have learnt so far.

So far we have practised writing the letters,
m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l h r j v
The next letters we are focusing on are
j and v

You could practise writing these letters in the air with your finger, then practise forming these letters using pens, pencils, paints etc.

The rhymes for these new letters are:

j - down the body, curl and dot for the head
v - down a wing, up a wing

Use the colour by numbers sheet and try to independently colour a pirate picture in the correct colours.
