So far we have practised writing the letters,

**m a s d t i n p g o c**

The next letters we are focusing on are

**K and U**

You could practise writing these letters in the air with your finger, then practise forming these letters using pens, pencils, paints etc.



**The rhymes for these new letters are:**

K- down the kangaroos body, tail and leg

U - down and under, up to the top and draw the puddle

### Nursery Rhymes


Can you also sing some numbered nursery rhymes:
