

Here are some ideas for Maths learning at home:

- Make toast with your child, ask them to give you instructions to follow. Talk about the sequence of the instructions. What happens if you do things in the wrong order? Write/draw or use photos of the steps of making toast, can your child put them in the correct order? Maybe you can think of other familiar events to sequence e.g. how to wash your hands/brushing your teeth
- Roll 2 dice and total the number of spots.
- Hold your own bingo night. Ask your child to write 6 numbers (choose numbers your child is confident with recognising) on a board or paper and play bingo. Take it in turns to be the caller.
